- To discuss innovative ideas and policies for improving urban living conditions.

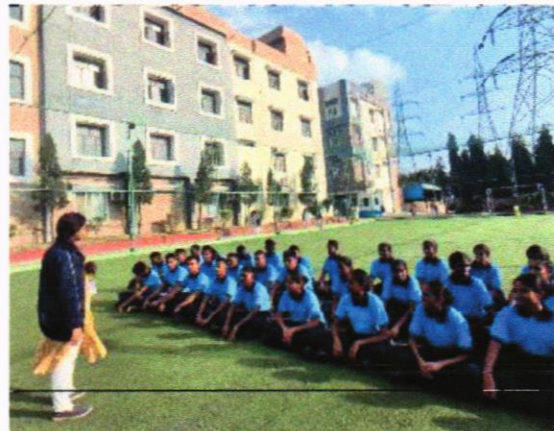
Expert speakers from the fields of **urban planning, environment, and architecture** presented insightful sessions on:

National Cadet Corps (NCC) Unit 1(T) Arty Bty

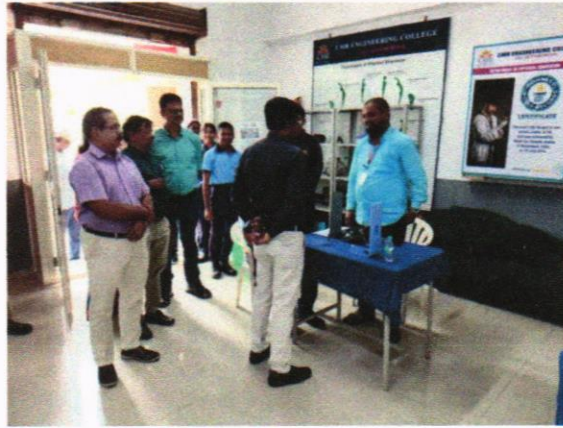
