REQUEST FOR PERMISSION TO CONDUCT SEMINAR ON WORLD HABITAT DAY


The NCC proposes to organize a **Seminar on World Habitat Day** to create awareness about the importance of sustainable urban development and housing for all.

- To discuss innovative ideas and policies for improving urban living conditions.

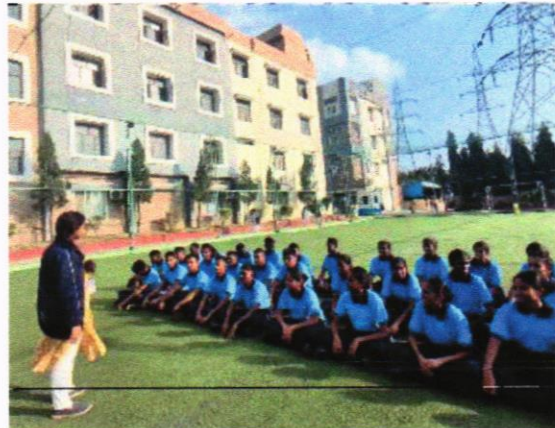
Expert speakers from the fields of **urban planning, environment, and architecture** presented insightful sessions on:
