Responsibility of the Committee:

- Ensure compliance with the Anti-Ragging Regulations and any relevant laws.
- Monitor and oversee the prevention of ragging within the institution.
- Investigate reports or incidents received from the Anti-Ragging Squad.
- Decide whether the incident is punishable under penal law and proceed to file an FIR if necessary.
- Conduct internal inquiries, provide recommendations, and report actions taken within seven days.
- Follow fair and transparent procedures and principles of natural justice.

- To strengthen digital monitoring through CCTV surveillance and complaint/reporting mechanisms.
- To introduce and strengthen peer mentoring and student volunteer systems for awareness, early identification, and prevention of disciplinary issues.
- To organize awareness programmes, workshops, orientation sessions, and counselling for freshers and senior students.
- To ensure strict compliance with applicable UGC, AICTE, and Government regulations relating to anti-ragging and student discipline.
- To improve documentation and ensure that all surveillance squads submit regular reports to the Principal and consolidated reports to the committee.

Resolutions

- The committee confirmed that no ragging incidents were reported during 2025–26. A few cases of indiscipline were discussed, including irregular attendance, inappropriate use of mobile phones during academic hours, and some minor issues. Appropriate warnings, counselling, and corrective measures were taken wherever required.
- The Anti-Ragging Committee, Disciplinary Committee, and Anti-Ragging/Surveillance Squads were formally reconstituted for the academic year 2026–27, with appropriate representation from faculty, administration, parents, students, and other relevant stakeholders.
- The Flying Squad, Gate Squad, Bus Stop Squad, Canteen Squad, Library Squad, Hostel Monitoring Squad, Girls Waiting Hall Squad, and Block/Laboratory Monitoring Squad were constituted with updated duty rosters and monitoring responsibilities.
- It was resolved to conduct mandatory anti-ragging and discipline awareness programmes during the beginning of the academic year, covering anti-ragging regulations, student code of conduct, grievance mechanisms, and counselling support.
- The peer-mentor and student volunteer system will be strengthened to encourage responsible student participation and create a positive and supportive campus environment.
- All squads were instructed to report any incident immediately to the concerned authority. Disciplinary matters will be reviewed promptly and appropriate action will be initiated without delay.
- A digital documentation and monitoring system will be maintained for recording surveillance reports, complaints, inquiries, warnings, counselling, and disciplinary actions.
- CCTV monitoring and surveillance coverage will be periodically reviewed, particularly in canteens, buses, newly opened blocks, laboratories, and other identified sensitive areas.
- The committee emphasized that preventive awareness, counselling, continuous monitoring, and timely intervention should be given priority to maintain a ragging-free and disciplined campus.
- The meeting concluded with the Principal and Dean of Academics appreciating the proactive efforts of all committee members and emphasizing that student safety, discipline, welfare, and a ragging-free academic environment will remain the highest priorities of CMR Engineering College for the academic year 2026–27.
